

Dear PTA, SFE Parents and Staff:

Since 1909 the Texas PTA has made available the Honorary Texas Lifetime Membership as one of the highest honors that may be presented to individuals for outstanding service to children and youth. The recipient does not have to be a PTA member, nor must the service for which the honor has been bestowed be connected with the PTA. It could be someone from the community, a parent or grandparent, a staff member, a volunteer - just to give a few examples. The only requirement for receiving this honor is that the recipient is making or has made a worthwhile contribution to the well-being of children and youth.

Texas PTA Life Members are exempt from paying the Texas PTA portion of dues for one local PTA per membership year, unless they have received more than one Honorary Life Membership. Past recipients include Maxine Fleming, Julie Waschak, Laura Buben, Lorie Rose, Lisa Grayson, and Sarah Reeder.

You can nominate someone who has already received the award from another school. It would be appropriate for one to receive the honor from more than one school, if we felt they were deserving

Typically, Shadow Forest Elementary School elects 3 Lifetime PTA Members out of all nominations. Please take a minute to consider nominating a worthy individual(s) for this honor.
